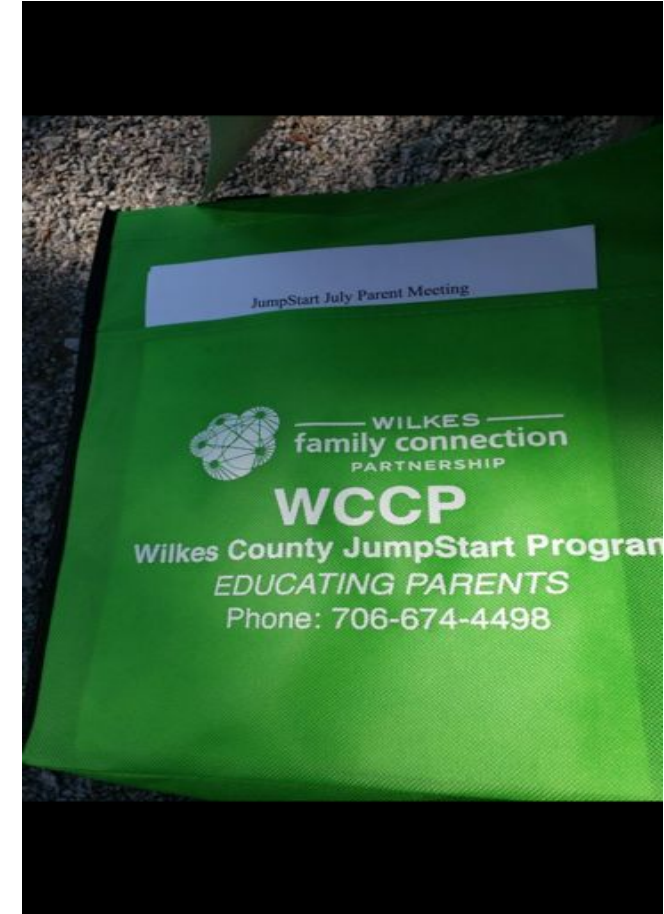

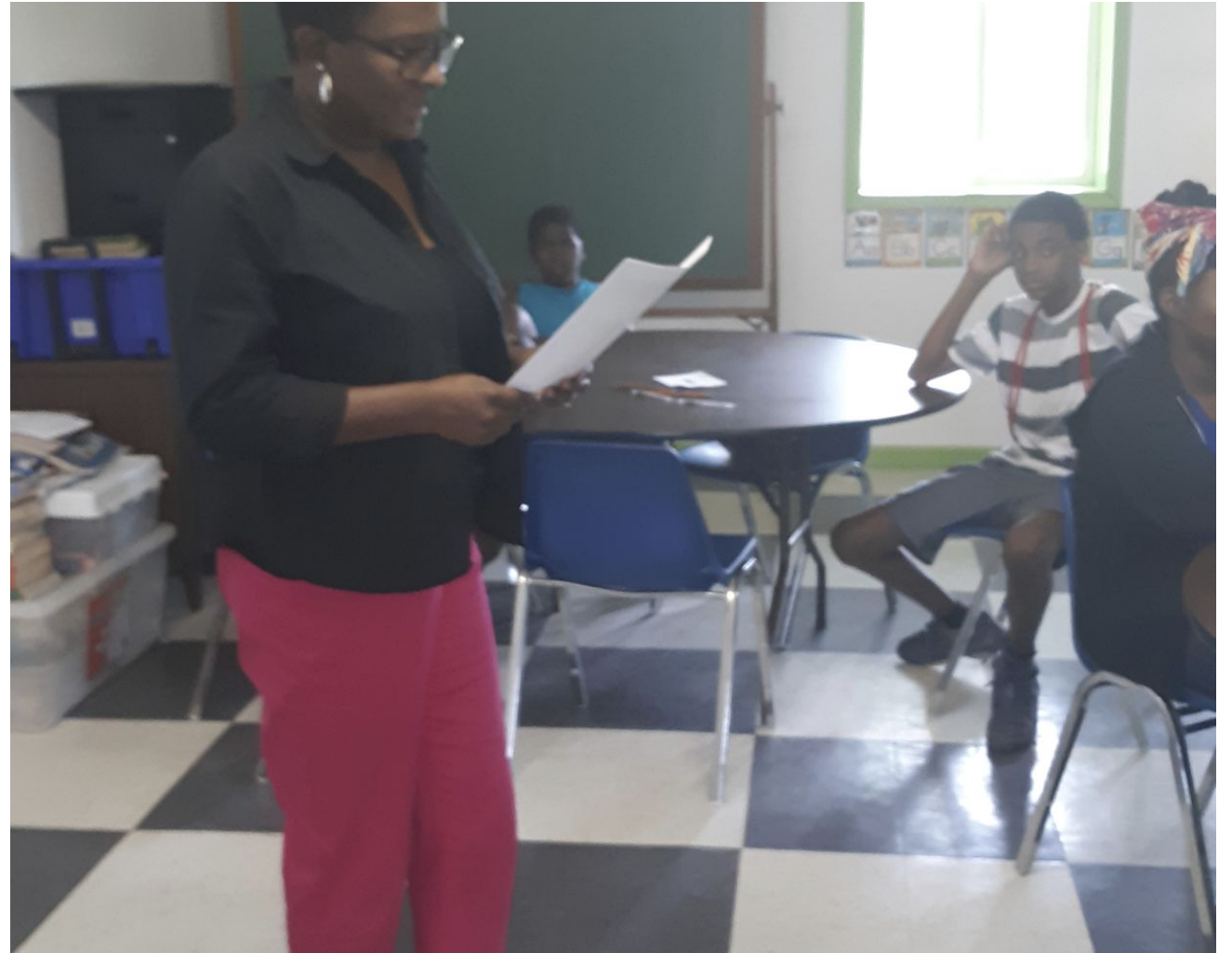
LaShaunder Elam-Lee, Prevention Consultant, meets with WWMS participants using the ***“Be A Friend First”*** Girl Scout Curriculum.

We also work with the Washington-Wilkes Middle School to offer TPP. We encourage good decision making regarding sexual health, with fun and interactive learning experiences designed to increase participation and help students understand the difficult topics being addressed.

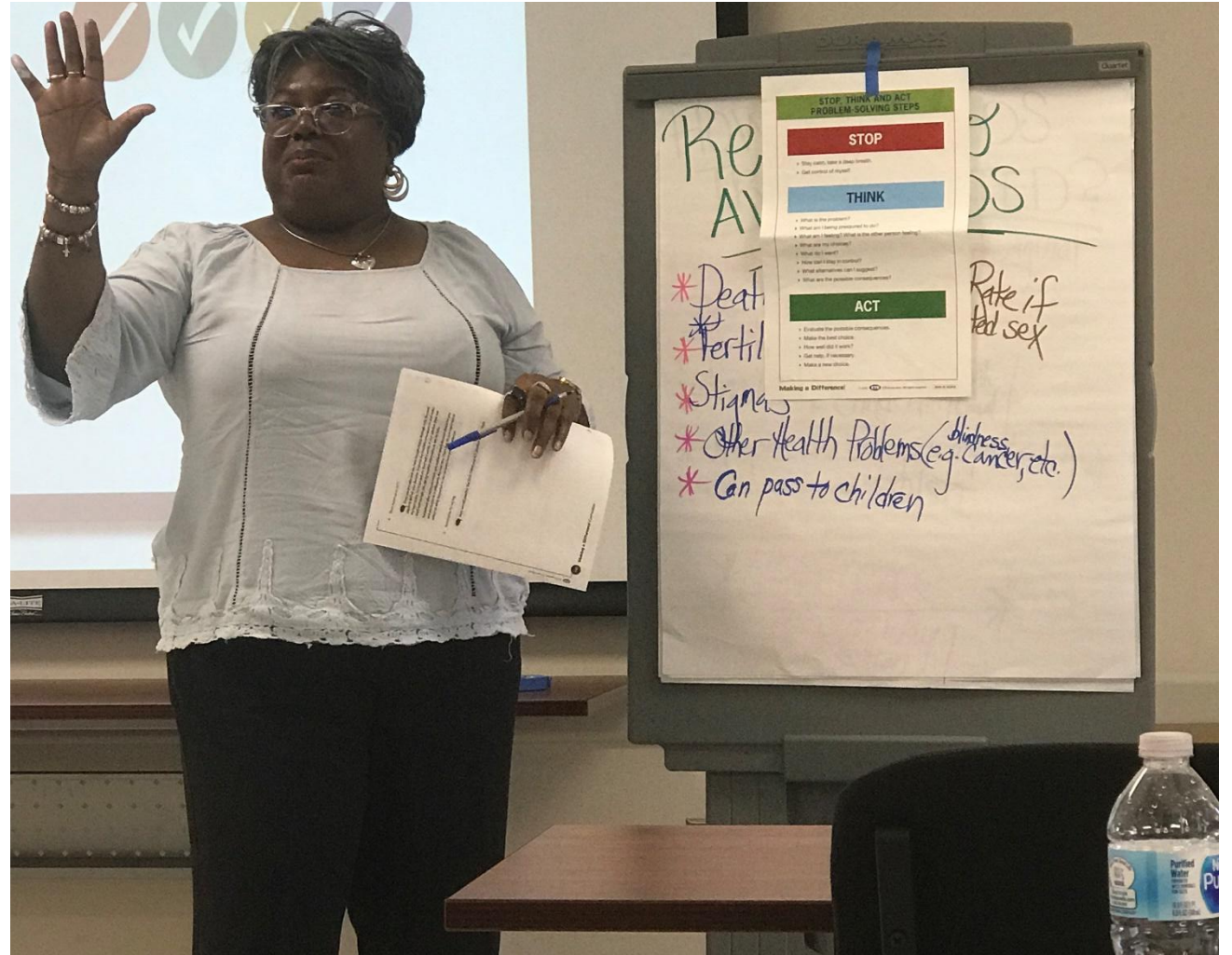
